Wallace / University of Alabama 1964: California = most populous state: rise of the 'Sun Belt' (+ 'Bible Belt'): SW/SE =/= NE and Midwest ('Rust Belt': labor unions, high taxes...) **1964:** Civil Rights Act (+ Voting Rights Act, 1965 = end of the Jim Crow laws) 1960s/70s: Riots and rise of 'Black Power' (Malcolm X) American Indian Movement (AIM) 1960s/70s: Counterculture Revolution ('Summer of Love' LSD, marijuana, Woodstock) 1965: Lyndon B. Johnson and 'Great Society' programs (welfare state, civil rights, Medicare) 1969: Apollo 11 (Neil Armstrong) **1972: Watergate scandal** (Nixon / Dems) → 1974 Nixon first to resign 1973: Roe v. Wade on abortion (Supreme Court) 1980s: Reagan Revolution ('America is back', Reaganomics, 'rollback', 'Evil Empire', SDI 1989-91: The End of History (Fukuyama) / 'New World Order' (George H. W. Bush) **1989: 'Washington Consensus':** neoliberalism, 'standard' reform package + IMF, WB 1991: Gulf War (Desert Storm, UN) → dominant superpower 1994: North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA) 1990s: high-tech boom, NASDAQ, 'dot-com bubble' → crash and recession 1999: Columbine High School massacre 2000: Bush v. Gore (SC, Florida), tax cuts, neoconservatism 2001, 9/11: 'War on terror', 'Axis of evil', Patriot Act, DHS, Afghanistan 2003: Iraq ; 'coalition of the willing' ; Guantanamo Bay ('Gitmo'), WMD 2008: Obama, first African-American: Don't Ask, Don't Tell Repeal Act (2010); Health care ('Obamacare' 2010), immigration reform (2013), financial reforms (2014) 2008-2009: Great Recession ('housing bubble' subprime mortgage crisis, bank bailout) 2007-2010: rise of Tea Party ('grassroots') / liberal Occupy (Occupy Wall Street) 2009: Federal minimum wage (at least \$7.25 per hour) 2011: Osama bin Laden killed / Iraq War over 2014, August: Michael Brown (Ferguson, Mo) / Eric Garner (+ 2012: Trayvon Martin) 2015: same-sex marriage (SC ruling) 2016, November: Trump President
